**THE QUARRYMEN'S STRIKE AT ROSENDALE.**

KINGSTON, N. Y., May 21.—Sheriff Saxton, having received several telegrams from Rosendale for assistance against the strikers in the cement quarries, this morning proceeded with the Twentieth Battalion, National Guard, consisting of Lieut. Col. Coddington, Major O'Reilly, Adjt. David S. Hasbrouck, and Companies B, D, and E, numbering over 100 men, with their officers, on chartered cars to the place of trouble. At the latest advices no resistance was offered and all is quiet.
